I am a part time resident of Bayview, my parents bought a float house at Boileau's in 1974, and I spend part of each summer there. I am interested in the no wake zone debate-- again being a float home resident.

When our float home FINALLY got sewer hook ups in 1992-- when Bayview put in a sewer system---- we were so thrilled!!!! However, these lines run under the dock in front of our place--- that the marina provides as a walkway and which we are moored to. So..... and our water lines run under this dock also. But imagine a 4th of July--- and 300 boats???? or however many are going in and out of Bayview--- at whatever speed they feel like. Our dock will be rolling up and down with all the wakes--- and how about our sewer lines???? and our water lines???? The lines could easily break--- causing a huge mess. Contaminated water, raw sewage leaking into the bay-- it could be a horrible problem. This is a good reason to leave this "No Wake" policy in place. Not just because we want it to be a no wake zone--- but for the reason of protecting our lines.

I hope this gives you and others another prospective on the "No Wake Zone" issue-- thanks for the updates from Bayview. I miss Northern Idaho as I am currently living Salt Lake City--Utah. I do get a month or so there as I work for the school district here and have time in the summer to visit.
